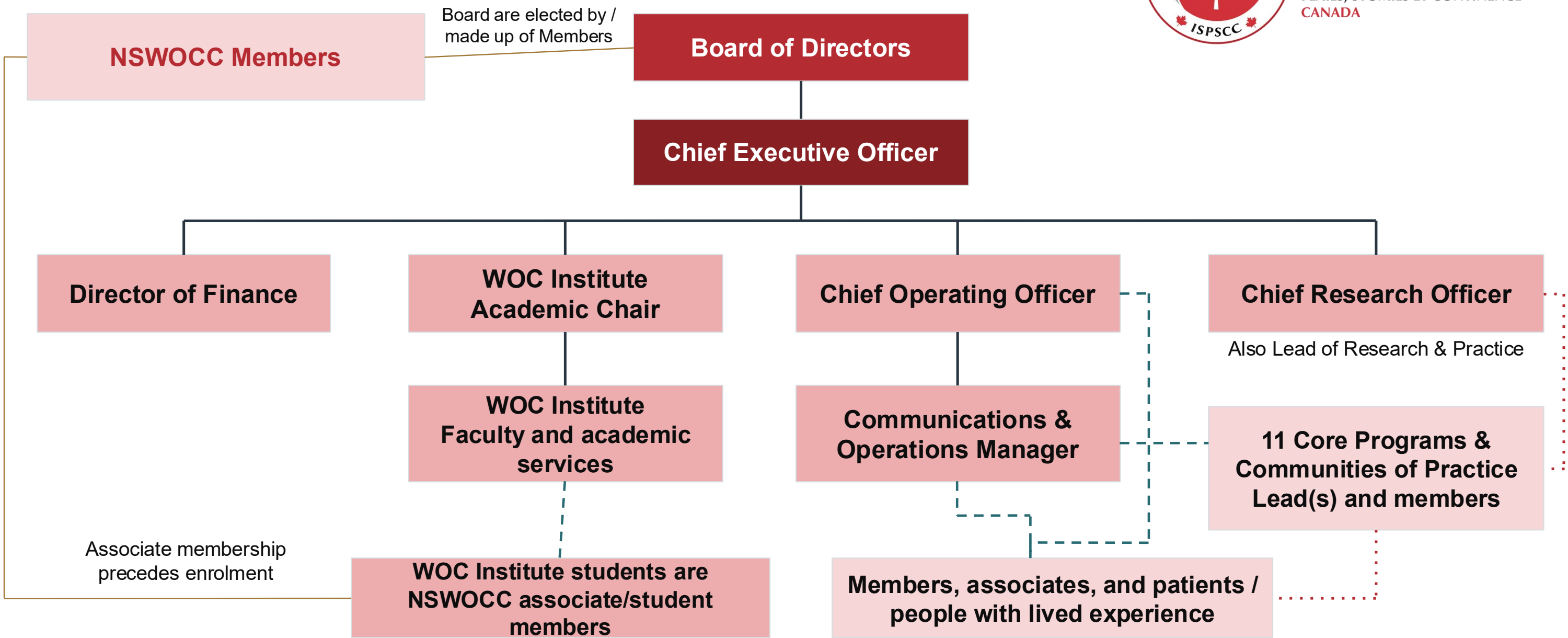


NSWOCC Organizational Ecosystem

Governance, executive leadership, education and member participation

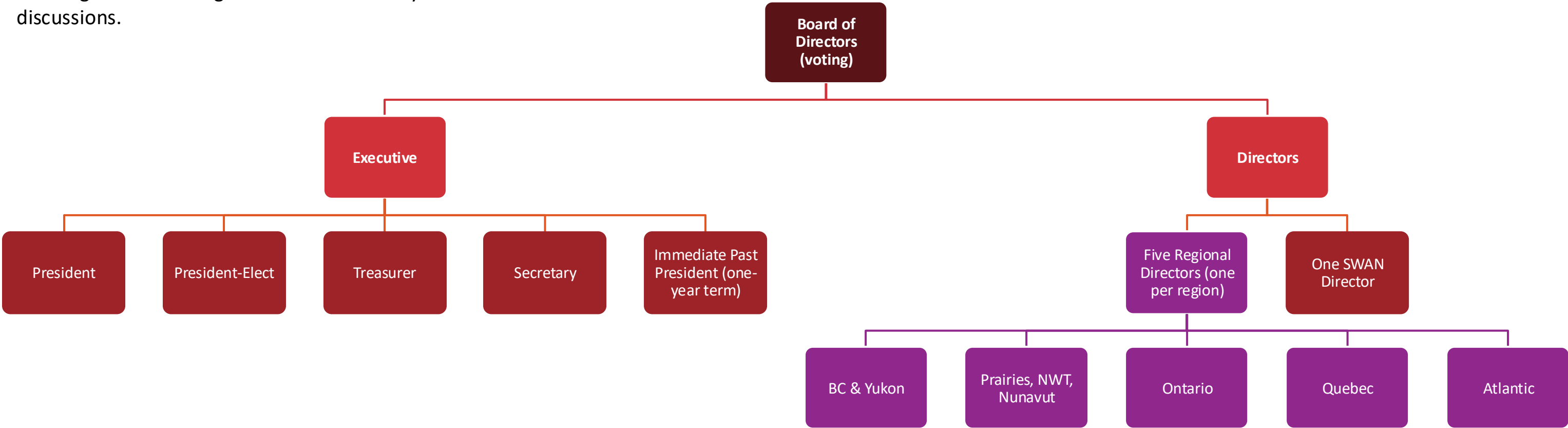


Students receive educational & admin support support. Core Program participation can include members, associates, staff and patients. Detailed structures follow.

NSWOCC Board of Directors

The NSWOCC Board of Directors comprises the Executive—President, President-Elect, Treasurer, Secretary, and Immediate Past President (for one year)—along with five Regional Directors, one representing each region, and one SWAN Director. Core Program Leaders attend Board meetings as non-voting members and are key contributors to Board discussions.

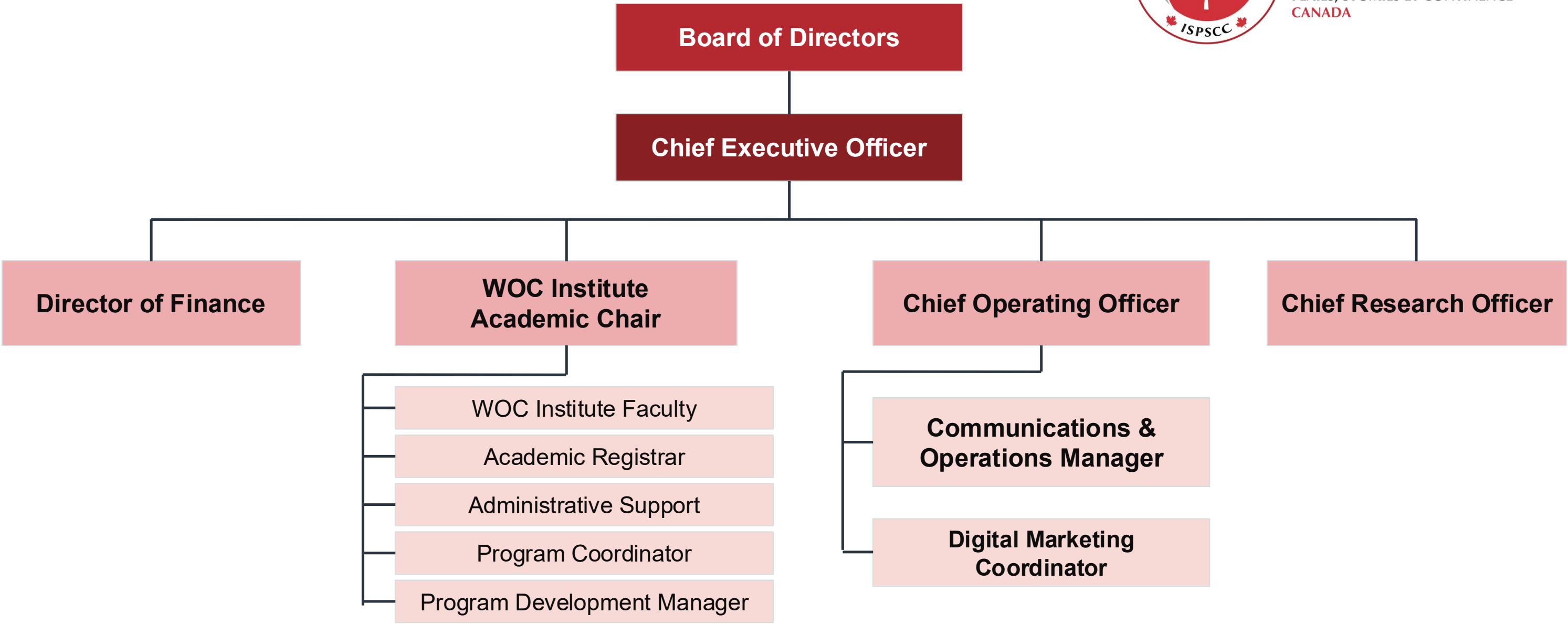


NSWOCC Operational Structure

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All four executive roles shown beneath the CEO are direct peer reports.

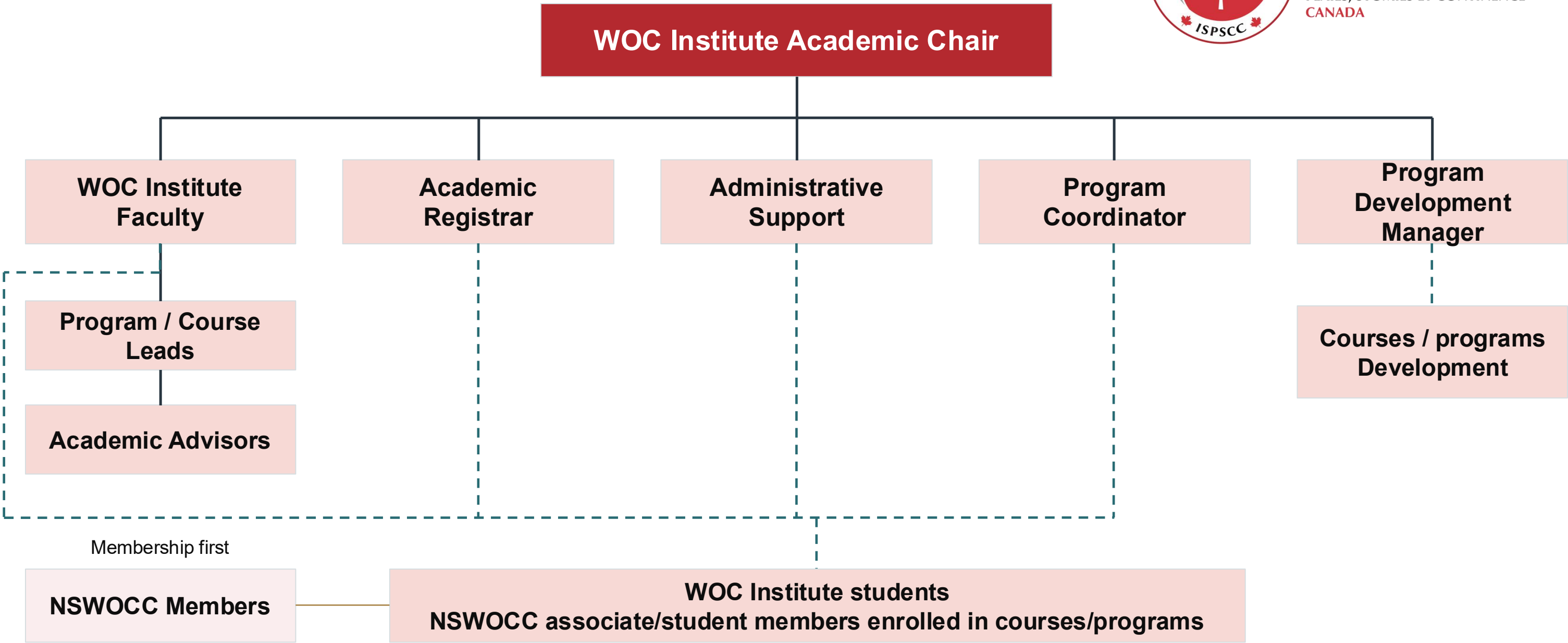

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Dashed lines show services to students. Students have no staff reporting relationship. Faculty support includes academic teaching and advising.

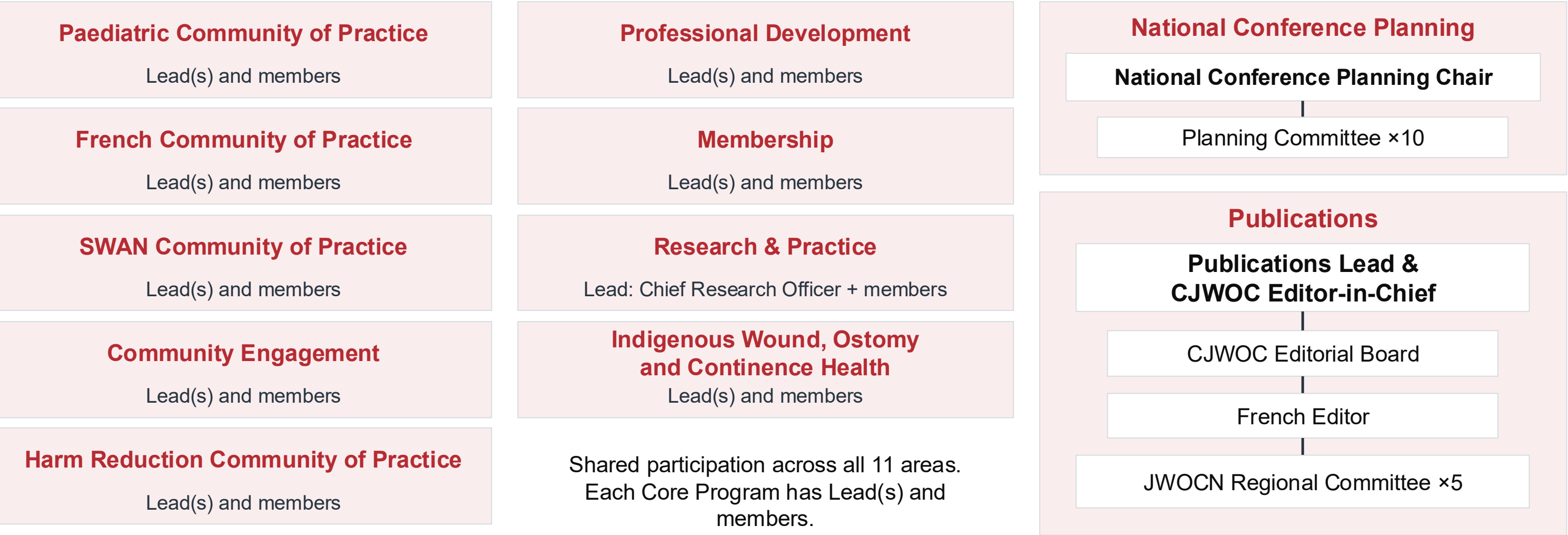
